LIST OF MENTAL HEALTH ITEMS - Version 8 (Tizón, J.L., Artigue, J.)*

LISMEN is an instrument for sistematized biographical exploration centered around childhood and adolescence. Its objetive is to collect a series of risk factors in the boy or girl with the purpose of being able to predict the possible onset of a serious emotional disorder. The items refer to observable facts that alter normal neurodevelopment and bonding processes at these ages.

This list can be applied by having a professional fill it out or during an interview with the patient and their family. Ask about the process which the item is referring to. For example, for cohabitation ask: At what age did the boy or girl begin to sleep alone? The questionnaire is linked to a glossary to simplify the understanding of the items.

Methodology: For the first application, select the list that corresponds with the child's age, for example if the child is 4 year old, select the 3-5 years section. Once this section has been filled out, explore the information available for the 0-2 years section. Proceed the same way when interviewing a 16 year old adolescent, filling out their own age section first and subsequently carrying out a retrospective exploration. Repeat its application, over the years, if considered necessary.

Score:

- -1: Absence, there is no presence of the risk factor mentioned in the item.
- 0: There is no available information on this item.
- 1: The risk factor mentioned in the item is present.

Rating: After an accumulation of 10 or more items, do a follow up of the possible emotional consequences of the indicated risk factors, and assess a recommendation for consult at a mental health service facility.
